MODIFIED SUNDAY SERVICES RESUME:

- "Soft-Reopening" will take place June 14 July 5
- All will enter & exit through the Main Entrance #5 (south side of building)
- Service times will be 9:00, 11:30 & 2:00 (time between services to allow participants to enter & exit safely and for cleaning/sanitizing to take place)
- Those wanting to attend a particular service will call the church office, 643-5713, in advance to "reserve" their desired time
- Each service will be held to 200 "reservations" to allow for staff, volunteers & guests who are unaware of the reservation system
- 9:00 service will be designated for those "at risk" or of "compromised health" (masks recommended)
- Those at risk or of compromised health with children or grandchildren who attend at 9:00 will have a designated section marked off for seating
- 11:30 and 2:00 services will have designated areas marked off for those who are compromised or at risk (not wanting to attend the 9:00 service)
- Offering visible receptacles will be placed at the south Worship Center entrance & online giving will
- continue to be encouraged
- Communion deacons preparing communion will wear gloves & masks; trays will be cleaned between services; the 2-cup stacked method will be used; communion stations will be set up at multiple locations; deacons will bring trays to stations near the end of the service; individuals/families can go to a station to partake of communion
- No children's Sunday School, programming or nursery will be provided (services limited to approx. one hour)
- No adult Sunday School classes on campus
- Shut-ins and those uncomfortable attending services at this time can call the church office, 643-5713, and a recording will be mailed to them on Mondays.
