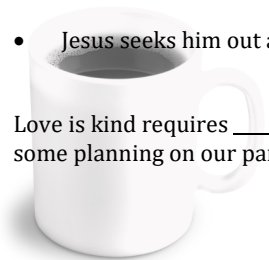
John 4:1-26 . . .
