"For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do" (Ephesians 2:10). Think of something your child excels at. Encourage your child to spend some time every day this week developing this gift and using it for good. Discuss ways he or she can use this gift for God. For example, a child who enjoys cooking could bake cookies for a friend or an older person who can't get around very well. A child who's good at art could make pictures with a Christian message and share them with a friend who does not yet believe in God.
