**MONTHLY****Toddler Bible Idea**

God is the Creator of everything.

FOR BY HIM ALL THINGS WERE CREATED. (COLOSSIANS 1:16)

WEEK 1 CREATION
GENESIS 1

In the very beginning, only God was there. God spoke and everything was made! God made the whole world. God made light and dark, water and sky, land, seas, and plants, the sun and the moon, fish, birds and land animals. God made people and called all of His creation good. He rested on the seventh day. God made everything and rules over everything.

WEEK 2 WONDERFULLY MADE
GENESIS 1:26-31; 2:4-25

God made Adam in His own image. Adam was told not to eat from the tree of knowledge of good and evil. God said Adam should not be alone. Adam named each creature in the garden, but none of them were a good helper for Adam. So God created Eve for Adam. They lived happily together in the garden of Eden in a close bond with God.

WEEK 3 THE FALL
GENESIS 3

God made a perfect world where people were close to God. A serpent tempted Eve. Adam and Eve ate the fruit from the tree God said not to. The world became broken by their sin. Sad and afraid, they hid from God. God still gave them hope. He promised to send Jesus to fix the world and save people.

WEEK 4 TOWER OF BABEL
GENESIS 11:1-9

God told people to spread out and fill the Earth, but they stayed in one place. They wanted to build a big city and tall tower to make their own names known and great. God helped them stop by confusing the words they spoke, so they could not understand each other. They stopped trying to build the city and spread out over the earth just as God had said to do.

WEEK 5 ABRAM AND LOT
GENESIS 12-15

God told Abram to leave his home and go to a new place. Abram left with his wife and nephew, named Lot. After a bit, there was not enough space for Abram's and Lot's animals to all live together. Abram let Lot pick which land to live in. Lot took the best land for himself but later ended up in trouble. Abram helped Lot. God reminded Abram of His promise.

BRITE IDEA:

God is the Creator of everything.

ACTIVITY:

Bring in leaves, rocks or flowers for toddlers to touch and explore. Say, "God made the plants and everything in the world!"

BRITE IDEA:

God created people in His image.

ACTIVITY:

Use pictures of people or dolls and have toddlers pair them together, saying, "God made friends to help each other!"

BRITE IDEA:

God is holy, but people sin.

ACTIVITY:

Play a gentle game of hide-and-seek with a small toy or yourself. Say, "Adam and Eve hid, but God still loves them!"

BRITE IDEA:

No one is greater than God.

ACTIVITY:

Let toddlers build towers with blocks, talking about how people wanted to make a big name for themselves.

BRITE IDEA:

God is in control.

ACTIVITY:

Draw two big "lands" on paper. Give toddlers toy animals or figures to place on the lands. Let them choose where to put their toys, just like Lot chose his land. Say, "God helped Abram even when Lot got into trouble!"
