



ISAIAH'S CALL

BIBLE PASSAGE (ISAIAH 6)

Summary: God gave Isaiah a vision of the heavenly temple. Isaiah saw God on His throne, high and lifted up. Angels called, "Holy, holy, holy!" The temple shook, and smoke filled the room. Isaiah realized he was sinful and said his lips were unclean. A seraph touched a coal to his lips, showing he was forgiven. Then God asked whom He could send with His message. Isaiah said, "Here I am! Send me!" God chose Isaiah to be His prophet.

Today's Brite Idea is: God is holy.

LEADER TRAINING: WORDING MATTERS

In preschool classrooms, the way we talk about rules matters more than we often realize.

- **Avoid negative phrasing.** Young kids are still learning language and self-control. Saying “No hitting” or “Don’t run” can backfire because their brains often focus on the behavior you’re trying to stop. For example, “Don’t run” can make a kid think “Run!” instead of “Walk inside.”
- **State expectations positively.** Use phrases like “I can use gentle hands and feet” or “I walk inside the space.” Positive rules tell kids exactly what to do, giving clear, actionable guidance instead of only limits.
- **Consider child development.** Preschoolers respond better to instructions they can follow because their self-regulation skills are still developing.
- **Reflect God’s truth.** Positive phrasing models what is good, kind and right. It helps preschoolers internalize healthy behaviors and creates a classroom environment that reflects both order and grace.

NAVIGATING A BROKEN WORLD: RIGHT AND WRONG

More than half of American adults say the situation someone is in can determine what is right or what is wrong.* Most people in today’s world don’t view right or wrong as absolute. However, the Bible is clear that God decides what is right and wrong. Preschoolers are still developmentally learning how to distinguish right from wrong. Help them learn about living God’s ways and not their own way. Because God is holy, He is the One who determines right and wrong, not people. Through His love, God offered His Son as a Savior to forgive our sins and teaches us what sin is.

GOD IS...

SUPPLIES:

2 balloons

PREP:

Inflate the balloons.

LEADER TIP: If any kids have a latex allergy, use a lightweight ball instead.

ACTIVITY INTRO:

Welcome everyone! My name is _____. *Greet each kid by name and welcome any new kids to the group.*

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. **Say:** Today we will learn about how God is holy. Can you say that with me? "God is holy!" Let's play a game and keep this balloon up in the air as we describe God in different ways.
2. *Gather kids together.*
3. *Throw the balloon into the air and lead kids to help keep it up. Add a second balloon as needed.*
4. **Use the statements below as you keep the balloon up.**
 - God is holy.
 - God is good.
 - God is faithful.
 - God is loving.
 - God is kind.
 - God is great.
 - God is all-powerful.
 - God is wise.
 - God is the Creator.
 - God is never-changing.
 - God is trustworthy.
5. **Ask:** What is your favorite thing about God?

**ACTIVITY WRAP-UP:**

God is so many things! I love learning more about God and who He is. We will learn more about how God is holy in today's Bible story. The word "holy" means to be set apart and perfect.

ISAIAH'S CALL

(ISAIAH 6)

Use the Bible story cards to teach the Bible story or read the script to the kids.



Say: God gave a man named Isaiah a very special dream. In this dream, Isaiah saw God sitting on a throne in His heavenly temple. God was high and lifted up, and His robe was so big, it filled the whole temple! Wow, that's big!

Say: Isaiah also saw special angels with six wings. Can you help me count to six: One, two, three, four, five, six! The angels worshiped God, saying to each other, **"Holy, holy, holy!"**

Say: When they spoke, the temple shook and it filled with smoke! Let's all wiggle like the temple in Isaiah's special dream.

Allow kids a moment to wiggle.

Say: Then Isaiah became afraid. He thought, "God is here, and I don't deserve to see Him! I've done wrong things, and God is perfect!" Just then, an angel flew to Isaiah with a hot coal and touched his lips. The angel said, "You are forgiven!"

Say: Then God spoke and asked, "Who will tell people My message?" Isaiah said, "Here I am! Send me!" Let's all raise our hands and say, "Here I am!"



POINT TO JESUS

Say: Isaiah knew he had sinned. Sin is anything we think, say or do that disobeys God. All of us sin, but we can be forgiven when we choose to believe in Jesus.

PRESCHOOL GLOSSARY:

Holy: set apart, perfect

Vision: a special picture or message shown by God

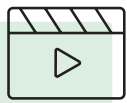

MEMORY VERSE MOTIONS:

Help kids recite and retain the memory verse by teaching it with motions. Before you teach the verse, be sure to explain what it means.

- Great (make a V with your arms)
- is the LORD, (point to the sky)
- and greatly (bring arms in and extend out to one side)
- to be praised. (bring arms in and extend out to the other side)
- Psalm 145:3 (open hands like a book)

HOLY LETTER HUNT

SUPPLIES:

Muffin tin, sticky notes, marker, heart stickers (1 per kid)

PREP:

Write each letter of the word "holy" onto separate sticky notes and fold each one in half. Place them randomly in the muffin tin cups. Put a heart sticker in any remaining muffin tin cups. Cover the top of each one with a sticky note to hide what is inside.

LEADER TIP: Some of the muffin cups will be empty. If a kid does not find a letter, encourage them to look again on their next try!

ACTIVITY INTRO:

The Bible teaches us true stories about God. Today we learned God is holy. The word "holy" means to be set apart and perfect. God does nothing wrong. He is totally good! We can follow God and know that He is good and holy and that He will forgive all our sins through Jesus.

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. **Say:** God is holy. Let's play a fun game where we find the letters that make up the word "holy." The letters we are going to look for are H, O, L and Y!
2. *Lay out the prepared muffin tin.*
3. *Gather kids around it and have each kid lift up a sticky note to see if they can find anything inside.*
4. *When kids do find a letter, set it aside until all the letters of "Holy" are found. Help kids spell it out.*
5. *Then put the sticky notes back and play again.*
6. *Pass out a heart sticker to each kid. Remind kids that God is holy and loves them so much.*
7. **Ask:** Who is holy?



ACTIVITY WRAP-UP:

God is holy! We can learn more about God from the Bible, and we can choose to follow Him.



LET IT SHINE

SUPPLIES:

Take-Home page, coloring supplies, plastic jar (1 per kid), tissue paper, scissors (prep), glue, battery-powered tealight candle (1 per kid), marker

PREP:

Print the Take-Home page (1 per kid). Cut the tissue paper into 2-inch-by-2-inch squares (1 handful per kid).

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. **Say:** We learned God is holy. We all sin, but God will forgive our sins when we choose to trust in Jesus.
2. **Say:** When we say God is holy, it means He is perfect and set apart. When we follow God, we can be a light to others and share about Him.
3. **Say:** Let's make a jar that will shine bright to remind us of God's holiness and how we can share the amazing message of who God is with others.
4. *Pass out a jar, a handful of precut tissue paper and glue to the kids. Help kids glue the tissue paper to the outside of the jar. Then place a battery-powered tealight candle inside the jar.*
5. **Ask:** What do you love about God?
6. *Use the marker to write each kid's name on the bottom of the jar and set aside for parent pickup.*

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- What did Isaiah see?
- Who is holy?
- Who can forgive all our sins?
- Whom did God choose to be His prophet?

**PRAY TOGETHER:**

Dear God, You are greater than anything! You are holy and great. Thank You for loving us. Help us to grow in our faith and follow You. Amen.

ACTIVITY WRAP-UP:

Give each kid a Take-Home page. With remaining time, kids can play in centers or color the Take-Home page.

CENTERS:

Set up 3–4 centers around the room for kids to explore and learn as they play. While kids explore the centers, leaders can work with individuals or small groups to make the craft. Set up each center in a separate part of the room, making sure all kids are visible at all times. Show the whole group what is in each center and give simple instructions on what kids should do in each center.

- **Magnetic Letters:** Provide cookie sheets with magnetic letters. Lead kids to stick different letters onto the cookie sheets. Place letters for “God” onto the sheet and share how God is holy.
- **Musical Time:** Provide musical instruments for kids to shake and play as they celebrate God’s holiness.
- **Creation Center:** Provide paper, coloring supplies, stamps and washable ink pads. Encourage kids to create a picture to give to someone and tell them God loves them.

BONUS SCRIPT:

Preschoolers learn best through repetition. Use the script below to review the story at any opportunity. You could review the story while kids play in centers, while they work on their craft, during snack time, or while waiting for parents.

Say: Isaiah saw something amazing! God gave Isaiah a vision of His heavenly temple. Isaiah saw God sitting on a big throne—high and lifted up because God is holy. Angels were flying around and calling, “Holy, holy, holy!” The whole place shook, and Isaiah knew he had sinned. But God forgave him and made him clean. Then God asked, “Who will go for Me?” And Isaiah said, “Here I am! Send me!” God chose Isaiah to share His message.
