WEEK 1 THE SUN STOOD STILL

JOSHUA 10, 13

Joshua was the new leader of God's people. When enemies came to fight, Joshua asked God for help. God made the enemies run away, but Joshua needed more time to win. So Joshua prayed, and God made the sun stand still! Wow! God kept His promise. He always does what He says.

WEEK 2 DEBORAH LEADS

JUDGES 4-5

God's people forgot about Him and were in trouble. God chose a woman named Deborah to help them. She told a man named Barak to lead the army. God helped His people win the battle! God wins every battle He fights. He is always the winner.

WEEK 3 HANNAH AND SAMUEL

1 SAMUEL 1-3

Hannah wanted a baby. She prayed and asked God for a son. God gave her Samuel. Hannah was so happy! When Samuel grew, he served at the temple. God called Samuel by name, and Samuel listened to Him.

WEEK 4 DAVID AND JONATHAN

1 SAMUEL 20

David and Jonathan were best friends and promised to take care of each other. Jonathan's dad was Saul, the king of Israel. But God had chosen David to replace him as king. King Saul was jealous of David. Jonathan helped to keep David safe. Jonathan was a good friend to David.

BRITE IDEA:

God does what He says.

ACTIVITY:

Say, "The sun is moving!" and have kids walk, hop, or wiggle around. Then say, "The sun stood still!" and everyone will freeze. Play several rounds with kids leading them in movement and then freezing still.

BRITE IDEA:

God is victorious.

ACTIVITY:

Drape a blanket over chairs to make a tiny tent. Lead kids to crawl inside and peek out. Each time they peek out, say, "God always wins!"

BRITE IDEA:

God cares about us.

ACTIVITY:

Sing a song to the tune of "Twinkle Twinkle, Little Star."

Say: God hears me when I pray, / Every night and every day. / Just like Hannah long ago, / God still loves me, this I know. / God hears me when I pray, / Every night and every day. Repeat the song with musical instruments. Lead kids to sing and shake their instruments to the song.

BRITE IDEA:

God's plan comes first.

ACTIVITY:

Tape a line of arrows using painter's tape in a path for kids to follow. Have the arrows point right, left, forward or backward. Lead kids to follow the arrows and jump to the direction they point toward. Share how Jonathan was a good friend to David.
